

## **Technical Specialist II**

### **Class Summary**

Under general supervision – primary responsibility for the system administration in an instructional networking environment; anticipates future technology needs, identifies areas for improved efficiency; performs new installations and modifications to existing systems; provide with problem resolution and computer repair; performs related duties as required.

### **Representative Duties**

Installs, secures, repairs, updates, and maintains computers, printers, and peripherals; configures and validates cloning systems (i.e. imaging); identifies and resolves hardware and software problems on network; performs administrative activities developing instructional systems to improve efficiency; identifies and escalates network issues, collaborates with infrastructure network specialist regarding updates or patches for standard district software; provides guidance to the users in the use of standard or specialized desktop applications; communicates with staff and faculty regarding software and hardware needs; sets up, configures, administers, monitors, maintains, tests, and troubleshoots servers; maintains liaison with vendors.

### **Organizational Relationships**

This positions reports to the designated supervisor.

### **Desirable Qualifications**

#### **Training and Experience**

Any combination of training and experience equivalent to a Bachelor's degree in a technology field and two years experience in a networking environment. Experience may be substituted for education.

#### **Knowledge and Abilities**

**Knowledge of:** Computer and networking terminology; Local area networks (LANs) and wide area networks (WANs); operations on servers, computers, networking, hardware and software.

**Ability to:** Stay apprised of current operating systems and software; diagnose problems and perform corrective action; establish and maintain effective relationship with others; interpret software and hardware documentation and technical manuals; prepare clear and concise reports; follow oral and written directions; follow safety practices in electrical and electronics work and in the use of tools and equipment.

**Physical Requirements:** Ability to lift 50 pounds.

**Working Conditions:** This position requires prolonged video display terminal viewing.
