## **SAC** Curriculum

- 2,905 course sections were offered at SAC in Fall 2005
- 9% (182) were coded DE (Developmental Education)
  - o 25 English sections
  - 41 ESL sections
  - 34 math sections
  - o 55 reading sections
  - 27 other course sections (Study Skills, Counseling, Speech, and Special Services)
- 49% of the DE courses were taught by full-time faculty

#### Enrollment

- **27,821** students enrolled at SAC in Fall 2005
  - 11% enrolled in at least one DE course
- 3,222 students were 1<sup>st</sup> time freshmen
  - o 34% enrolled in at least one DE course
- 92% of the DE students are non-white
- 72% of the DE students are under 20 years-old

#### Test Placement

- 2,089 students took the reading placement test
  - o 63% placed in N90/095 or below
- 2,775 students took the math test
  - o 32% placed in N05, N06, N48
- 3,411 students took the ESL/EMLS and English tests
  - 45% placed in ESL N40A, N40B, N49, 055, 107, 109,
    110 and English N50, N06

## **Overall Outcomes**

- 4,313 DE grades were given in Fall 2005
  - o 60% were successful (A,B,C,Cr)
  - o 40% were unsuccessful (D,F,NCr,W)
- 20% (872) withdrew from a DE course

## **English**

- 2,812 students enrolled in English during Fall 2005
  - o 27% enrolled in DE English courses (N50, N60)
- 1,002 1<sup>st</sup> time freshmen enrolled in English
  - 43% enrolled in DE English courses
- 100 English sections were offered
  - o 25% were DE sections
  - o 36% of the DE sections were taught by full-time faculty
- 755 DE English grades were given
  - 46% were successful (A,B,C,Cr)
- 24% withdrew from a DE English course

#### **ESL**

- 1,419 students enrolled in ESL during Fall 2005
  - 86% enrolled in DE ESL courses (N40A, N40B, N49, 055, 107, 109, 110)
- 343 1<sup>st</sup> time freshmen enrolled in ESL
  - 99% enrolled in DE ESL courses
- 48 ESL sections were offered
  - o 95% were DE sections
  - o 73% of the DE sections were taught by full-time faculty
- 1,222 DE ESL grades were given
  - o 66% were successful (A,B,C,Cr)
- 16% withdrew from a DE ESL course

#### Math

- 4,473 students enrolled in math during Fall 2005
  - o 22% enrolled in DE math courses (N05, N06, N48)
- 1,228 1<sup>st</sup> time freshmen enrolled in math
  - 33% enrolled in DE math courses
- 132 math sections were offered
  - o 26% were DE sections
  - o 50% of the DE sections were taught by full-time faculty
- 965 DE math grades were given
  - o 53% were successful (A,B,C,Cr)
- 25% withdrew from a DE math course

## Reading

- 804 students enrolled in reading during Fall 2005
  - 92% enrolled in DE reading courses (N80A, N80B, N90A, N90B)
- 420 1<sup>st</sup> time freshmen enrolled in reading
  - 94% enrolled in DE reading courses
- 69 reading sections were offered
  - o 80% were DE sections
  - o 36% of the DE sections were taught by full-time faculty
- 741 DE reading grades were given
  - o 61% were successful (A,B,C,Cr)
- 23% withdrew from a DE reading course
