

Rancho Santiago Community College District (RSCCD) Success Rate by Ethnicity and Its Disproportionate Impact for AB705 Cohort, Spring 2020


Definition:

- The <u>cohort</u> consists of students who enrolled in any of the placement courses for English (or math) at the college in Spring 2020 and received a letter grade (excluding EW) but never took a credit English (or math) course prior to Spring 2020 at the college.
- <u>Success rate</u> is defined as the proportion of the cohort who successfully completed at least one English (or math) course upon entering the sequence; this is computed by the unduplicated count of students who earned at least one passing grade (A, B, C, or P) in Spring 2020 divided by the total student count for the cohort/subgroup.
- <u>Disproportionate impact</u> occurs when a subgroup of students based on particular characteristics—ethnicity for this study—experiences lower outcomes compared to the total student population.
- This study uses percentage point gap (PPG) approach with error of margin (E) based on a <u>95% confidence level</u> to measure the disproportionate impact for success rate by ethnicity. PPG is calculated by subtracting the overall average success rate from the success rate of a disaggregated subgroup; whereas E is computed based on a 95% confidence level and the given size of each subgroup. As the sample size gets smaller, the margin of error increases. Disproportionate impact occurs when PPG $\leq -E\%$.
 - Green bar indicates no disproportionate impact and the subgroup's success rate is above/at the overall average success rate.
 - Yellow bar indicates no disproportionate impact but the subgroup's success rate is below the overall average success rate.
 - Red bar indicates the subgroup is disproportionately lower than the overall population.




