


## Santa Ana College Summary of Degrees and Certificates Awarded

## January 2018

One important metric of institutional effectiveness is the number of degrees and certificates that an institution awards. Therefore, it is important to regularly assess and monitor this data to ensure the appropriate programs and services are provided to all students who attend Santa Ana College. This report examines trends in the number of associate degrees, certificates of achievement and certificates of proficiency awarded, types of awards by major, and who earned the awards over a five-year timeline from 2012-13 through 2016-17.



Santa Ana College experienced an uptrend in the number of associate degrees awarded (including associate degrees for transfer) over the five years observed, increasing from 1691 in 2012-13 to 2451 in 2016-17.

- There was a surge in the number of awarded certificates of achievement from 2013-14 to 2014-15 (1511 to 3471, respectively), followed by a significant decrease the following year (2136), and a further decline in 2016-17 (2026). Changes were due to the implementation of the degree audit system.
- The notable increases in the number of awarded certificates of proficiency from 2013-14 to 2014-15 (185 to 558, respectively) and 2015-16 to 2016-17 (175 to 1477, respectively) were also due to the implementation of the degree audit system, which captured many individuals who qualified for their certificate of proficiency.

- Latino students received the most proportion of associate degrees (65%), certificates of achievement (67%), and certificates of proficiency (54%), followed by Asian students (15%, 14%, and 27%, respectively).
- There was a slight increase (12 percentage points) among Asians and a similar decrease (14 percentage points) among Latinos receiving certificates of proficiency compared to the prior year.

Santa Ana College Top Awarded Majors, 2016-17

- The highest number of awarded associate degrees were in Liberal Arts (46%), followed by Business Administration (9%), Psychology, Nursing - Registered Nursing (4% each), and Criminal Justice (3%).
- The majority of awarded certificates of achievement were in the areas of CSU and IGETC General Education Breadth (41% and 16%, respectively). The next areas with the most awards included Medical Assistant-Administrative/Clinical (6%), Public Fire Service (4%), and Diesel - Mid-Range Engine (3%).
- Most certificates of proficiency were awarded in Auto CAD 2D Basics (45%), followed by Survey of International Business (13%), Computer Fundamentals for Business (10%), Global Trade Skills (8%), and Corrections Officer (3%).
