

## Santiago Canyon College Transfer-Level Course Success for Students Enrolled With Different Levels of English Acquisition Fall 2007-Fall 2009

Recent interest around the state regarding pre-requisites prompted the RSCCD Research Department to compile data that could be used by Santiago Canyon College faculty to initiate a discussion locally. Student records were analyzed to see if English acquisition has an impact on transfer-level course success for the last three fall semesters (Fall 2007, Fall 2008, and Fall 2009). The four levels of English leading to transfer that we analyzed are: English N50 (Introduction to Written Communication), English N60 (Basics of Effective Writing), English 061 (Introduction to Composition) and English 101 (Freshman Composition).

The table (on the next page) shows the number of grades given and percent of those who were successful in the transfer-level course by the English course that they successfully completed (with a grade of A, B, C, or Cr) concurrently or prior to the semester of the transfer-level course enrollment. The table contains courses in almost every major department; however, labs, seminars and academies are NOT included in this analysis. Only transferable courses with 100 or more enrollments were included. Findings include:

- Overall, the higher English acquisition, the higher the rate of success in transfer-level courses.
- There were minor exceptions to this overall findings:
  - o Courses such as Anthropology 100 and Biology 239, Criminal Justice 101 counts were very small so each count equates to large percentage differences
  - Courses such as Computer 100 and Math 170 may not entail as much English as other courses.

Without a doubt, there are many other intervening variables that faculty should consider when assessing the impact of pre-requisites/co-requisites on students' success in any course. The intention of this piece is to start a discussion that could provoke further investigation/research prior to implementing such pre-requisites/co-requisites in their classroom. The Research Department will be happy to assist faculty having content expertise to guide the process.
