

# **Enrollment and Outcomes Trends of City of Orange High School Graduates Who Matriculate to Santiago Canyon College**

#### Compiled by RSCCD Research Department, December 2014

#### **Background**

For over a decade, now, we have tracked new graduates from high schools in the City of Orange who matriculate to Santiago Canyon College (SCC). Groups of students—cohorts—are comprised of students who last attended high schools in Orange, ages 17-19, who enrolled for the first-time at SCC in the fall semesters of 2009 through 2013.

#### **Summary Findings**

- ➤ Matriculants to SCC: The number of graduates from Orange high schools decreased, overall, about 9% from Fall 2011 to Fall 2013. Most notable are decreases in numbers of matriculants from Canyon and El Modena high schools.
- ➤ Course Success at SCC: Across all courses enrolled, , matriculants from Orange high schools succeeded at higher rates than those of five years prior (after peaking in 2011 and 2012).
- ➤ Basic Skills Course Advisements: Overall, a smaller proportion of OUSD matriculants were advised into college-level math (-3 percentage points) and English (-4 percentage points).
- ➤ **Persistence:** Overall, OUSD matriculants to SCC persisted to a second and third semester at rates consistent with prior Fall semesters (with the exception of a spike in 2012).
- ➤ Transfers to 4-year colleges: Over one-third (38%) of cohort student transfers enrolled in California State University at Fullerton.

Detail data for matriculants from each of the high schools are included in this report.
