

Santa Ana College-School of Continuing Education Student Satisfaction Survey Results, Spring 2017

July 2017

As an educational institution, it is imperative that we regularly monitor student satisfaction to understand how particular issues, if any, impact their perception of program offerings, learning environment, support services and resources available, as well as facilities usage as it relates to the Santa Ana College School of Continuing Education (SAC-SCE). The findings will assist us to serve the educational needs of our adult learners/students.

At the end of spring 2017, staff conducted an online student satisfaction survey of the continuing education students actively enrolled at the four main SAC-SCE sites (Santa Ana College, Centennial Education Center, Godinez High School and Santa Ana High School). The survey provided an opportunity for them to report their levels of satisfaction with the programs, services, and resources available to them at SAC-SCE. In addition, the survey included questions regarding their educational background, demographics, future class offerings, and quality of services and programs.

Respondents come from diverse demographic and economic backgrounds. Slightly over one-quarter (29%) have received some college education and forty-seven percent have less than a high school diploma. More than half of the respondents are 30 years of age or older (79%), female (63%) and Latino (76%). Though respondents identified numerous native languages, nearly three-fourths of the respondents' primary language is Spanish (73%). More than two-thirds (72%) of the respondents stated they reside in households of three or more family members, with low annual household income (66% with less than \$40,000 per year), while slightly over one-half of the respondents worked full and/or part-time (52%). About two-thirds of the respondents (63%) had their own transportation to school, while others depended on public transportation (17%), walking (16%), being dropped off (13%), riding bicycle (4%) or carpooling (2%).

The majority of the respondents (63%) took classes at the Centennial Education Center, about one-quarter (23%) at the SAC main campus, while ten percent attended classes at the Godinez and Santa Ana High Schools. The majority of the respondents (60%) enrolled at SAC-SCE for less than a year, for one to two years (28%) and for three or more years (12%). Survey respondents came to SAC-SCE for various reasons: to learn English (85%), to obtain a better job (45%), to obtain a high school diploma (30%), to obtain a CTE/computer training certificate (23%), to help their children with school work (22%) and to prepare for college/university studies (20%).

This report summarizes the opinions and perceptions of the 1881 students who completed the survey. In addition, it compares specific percentages reported in the 2014 SAC-SCE Student Satisfaction survey and those reported this year to assist staff in measuring/determining the progress.

Summary of Results:

- Students have the option to enroll in various programs and some enroll in multiple programs; therefore, the percentage total may exceed 100%. The percentages of responses are as follow: English as a Second Language (86%), Career Technical Education (CTE)/Computer Training (14%), Adult Basic Education (12%), Adult High School Diploma (8%), Program for Older Adults (5%), General Education Development (4%), Health & Safety Education (2%), Parenting Education (2%), Programs for Adults with Disabilities (1%) and other programs (5%).
- Respondents' level of satisfaction with their experiences at SAC-SCE ranged from a low 80% to a high of 95%.
 - o Most of the respondents were very satisfied with their classroom experience (95%), quality of instruction, campus safety/security and overall experience (each 93%) at SAC-SCE. Although still high, "availability of parking" received the lowest satisfaction rating of 79%.
 - o Satisfaction with availability of parking was low (56%) in 2014 and improved this year with a 23-point gain to 79%. Though not as high, satisfaction with campus safety/security improved with a eight-point gain to 93% from 85% in 2014.
- Although respondents <u>do not</u> use many programs and services available to them for support as they pursue their college education, satisfaction ratings with most of these services, in general, were slightly higher than they were in 2014.
 - Only about one-half of the respondents used five out of the eight programs/services available to them. The most often used services were "required" ones in which they need to select and enroll in classes, such as Admissions and Registration Office (96%) and the Assessment/Orientation Office (87%). Both programs received the highest ratings of satisfaction (94% and 93%, respectively).
 - o Students' satisfaction with the Disabled Student Programs and Services is up 9% this year from 80% in 2014.
- Respondents rated how engaged they were both academically and socially while attending SAC-SCE. The highest rated category was, "I would recommend SAC-SCE to a friend/family" (98%). The majority of the respondents also "strongly agreed" and "agreed" that SAC-SCE "supports a community of diverse cultures" (96%). Although still high, the lowest rated category was, "faculty and staff care about me as an individual" (90%).
- Respondents would like to attend the various and multiple courses to reach their goals: ESL (82%), CTE/computer training (27%), Adult High School Diploma (27%), ABE (23%), Citizenship (21%), and GED (18%). Note that some respondents selected more than one response option and as a result, the percentage total does not add up to 100%.

• Word-of-mouth is the best form of advertisement for the SAC-SCE program (69%). Comments with similar statements were grouped with a number in parentheses to show how many shared that similar view. Respondents complimented the helpful staff and faculty, the quality of education, as well as the many programs and resources available; however, they also made suggestions for improvements (such as the need for more classes, more bilingual teachers, childcare, better parking, and better classroom technology). Staff are encouraged to read the comments, as they are very informative and can help to serve our adult learners/students.
