The meeting was called to order by Mr. Hardash at 1:35 p.m.

State Budget Update

- \$16 Billion state budget deficit
- Plan "A" SB69 and SB70 education trailer bills signed into law on March 24, 2011. Loss in Revenue for RSCCD (\$7.1 million)
- Plan "B" Scenario-Pro 98 minimum funding
 - Loss in apportionment revenue for RSCCD (\$12.4 million)
 - SAC @ 71.27% workload measure reduction (\$8,837,480)
 - SCC @ 28.73% workload measure reduction (\$3,562,520)
 - Loss in Lottery Revenue for RSCCD projected at (\$250,000)
 - SAC @71.27% (\$178,175)
 - SCC @ 28.73% (\$71,825)
- Plan "C" Scenario-All cuts budget loss in revenue for RSCCD (\$20 million)
 - o No votes in the Legislature to implement this scenario
- Potential Community College Budget Reductions from LAO submitted to Legislature for discussion
 - Establish 90 unit cap on each student's taxpayer-subsidized CCC credits (\$250 million)
 - o Increase to \$66/unit (\$170 million)
 - Reduce Funding for credit basic skills instruction to the rate provided for noncredit basic skills (\$125 million)
 - o Eliminate state funding for intercollegiate athletics (\$55 million)
 - Eliminate State funding for repetition of credit physical education and fine arts classes (\$55 million)
 - o Eliminate state funding for noncredit PE and fine arts classes (\$30 million)
 - o Total (\$685 million reduction)

RSCCD 2011-12 Tentative Budget

- Projected ending fund balance includes \$25 million I.O.U. from the state
- Roll over budget
- One- time funds from FY 2010-11 will be reversed in FY 11-12
 - o \$400,000 from available election funds
 - SAC (\$100,000)

- SCC (\$300,000)
- o \$500,000 one time allocation
 - SCC (\$500,000)

RSCCD 2011-12 Tentative Budget Assumption

- Mr. Fujimoto moved to approve the 2011-12 Tentative Budget Assumptions and Mr. Hicks seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.
- Dr. McMillan also approved the use of the District's current budget allocation model, for the 2011-12 Tentative Budget, but request further review and discussion on how the Adopted Budget, for FY 2011-12, will be constructed.
- June 8th BAPRC meeting will be spent on reviewing the draft of the SB361 Revenue Allocation Model
