## **Enrollment Patterns and Progress of ABE Students**

## **Summary of Findings**

Transcripts were analyzed to identify enrollment patterns of students enrolled in ABE coursework at Centennial Education Center (CEC). Students are included in a cohort group based only upon their active enrollment in an ABE course at CEC a given semester; students may be included in multiple cohorts. Additionally, analyses include only two years of activity subsequent to the cohort semester (with the exception of credit coursework enrolled in, which extends through the Fall 2010 semester for all cohorts).
