# Santa Ana College <br> Does Curriculum Change in Selected English/EMLS Courses Enhance Successful Course Completion?

In Fall 2007, faculty implemented a curriculum change that requires students enrolled in English N60 and 061 and English for Multilingual Students (EMLS) 112 to spend an additional 16 hours a semester outside of class time in the Writing Center. In addition to faculty providing structured instruction during these sessions, the students are also welcome to bring their composition for individualized tutoring. Faculty believes that if students have the additional one-on-one assistance, they can easily identify their writing errors and develop the skills needed to correct them. After three years, faculty wants to know if the changes influence the success rates of those enrolled in these courses. Findings include:

- Successful course completion rates for English N60 compared to those enrolled in the courses prior to the curriculum changes (Fall 2006) show minor progress.
- Students enrolled in English 061 during the last five fall semesters were more successful (an average of two to seven percentage points) than those enrolled Fall 2006.
- Grade distributions for EMLS 112 also show promising growth (from a drop in five percentage point the first year of implementation to an increase of one to nine percentage points in the following three fall semesters).

There may be other intervening variables that faculty may want to consider when assessing the full impact that participation in the Writing Center has on students’ success in these three courses; further investigation is recommended.
