Mr. Hardash called the meeting to order at 1:35 p.m.

2008-09 and 2009-10 Budget Update

Mr. Hardash reviewed the following information:

- 1. No State Budget
- 2. Preliminary P-1 Update
 - P-1 calculation for prior year shows more property tax shortfall
 - \$100 million shortfall this year system wide, \$2.4 million to RSCCD

Health and Welfare Cost Projection

- PPO approximate increase 15.6%
- HMO approximate increase 12.9%
- Dental PPO approximate increase 7.3% Approximate Net cost to district \$2.3 million, 10% cap in district cost

Accreditation Report

- Both colleges were placed on "warning" status by the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges.
- Follow-up report is due by October 15, 2009.
- As of yet, Barbara Beno has not responded to further information and clarification on recommendations.

Mr. Vazquez opened the discussion with questions "Does the District have a planning process?" How do we integrate the planning from the colleges with the district?

Mr. Didion stated the Board of Trustees sets its vision/planning goals which then flow through the Chancellor, the Chancellor's Cabinet and to the staff. In addition, the Board receives an annual report from Human Resources on diversity and turnover.

Dr. Hernandez stated the role of the BAPR Planning Sub Committee was to recommend to the BAPR committee the evaluation and connection of the sites goals to the goals of the district.

Mr. Didion stated, the vision was intended to integrate and initiate work between the sub committes and then to integrate with Research and Development, BOT goals and visions, Human Resources, and Budgeting.

Mr. Barembaum stated from the senate point of view, there is a disconnect from what occurs at the sites to what ultimately happens at the district.

Dr. McMillan agreed and stated there are gaps in the process which need to be identified and begin to repair.

Dr. Hernandez added the BAPR work group needs to be more involved and specific in their tasks. Mr.Didion suggested an inventory of all the group's goals and compile an inventory list. In turn the Academic Senates need to identify the gaps and weaknesses. He recommends for the next meeting we come back with strategic goals.
