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### Fund 41 Capital Outlay Projects Fund

#### Budget & Accounting Manual Definitions and Code Guidance

- Acquisition or construction of new capital facilities (e.g. land, buildings, site improvements)
- Significant capital equipment purchases
- Improvements or extensions to life of existing capital facilities (major repairs and remodeling)
- Public Works Projects Public Contracts Code §§22002(c), 22002(d): Construction, reconstruction, erection, alteration, renovation, improvement, demolition, and repair work involving any publicly owned, leased, or operated facilities
- Scheduled Maintenance and Special Repair (SMSR) as defined in Education Code §84660 "unusual, nonrecurring work to restore a facility to a safe and continually usable condition for which it was intended". These items are divided into five funding categories; roofs, utility, mechanical, exterior, and other
- EDC §§81800-81839 Community College Construction Act of 1980
- Capital Outlay Plans for Construction EDC §§81820-81823

The governing board of each community college district shall prepare and submit to the Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges a plan for capital construction for community college purposes of the district...

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#### Capital Construction Revenue

- Scheduled Maintenance funds (state)
- Local revenue (over 15 years of contributions)
- Local general obligation bonds, etc.
- Leases
- Interest
- Non-resident tuition (managed by colleges)
- Redevelopment (managed by site)
- Utility rebates/Incentives by project



### State Funded Capital Projects

- State moneys for Scheduled Maintenance and Special Repair (SMSR) projects are recorded directly into this fund.
- Every year the District Office Facilities Department meets with the College to update their 5-Year Scheduled Maintenance Plan and submit various projects for funding. Plan is typically due every October 1st.
- State funded new capital construction projects are also recorded directly into this fund (e.g. SAC Health Sciences/Russell Hall Replacement project).



### Capital Construction Project Accounting

- Principles & Practices of Capital Construction Project Accounting
  - Project budgets & expenditures
  - Unique project id (4 digit code)
  - By site/location
  - By project type (Scheduled Maintenance, Campus Requests, Capital Repairs/Improvements, etc.)
  - Expenditures by 6000 Object Code(s) & Capitalization
  - Over 140 Object Codes
  - Districtwide projects
- State Funded Projects (Capital and/or Scheduled Maintenance)
- Projects may carry over from one fiscal year to the next if not completed
- Project Close-out Accounting: DSA, State, Fiscal, etc.

- Districtwide Infrastructure (e.g. ITS)



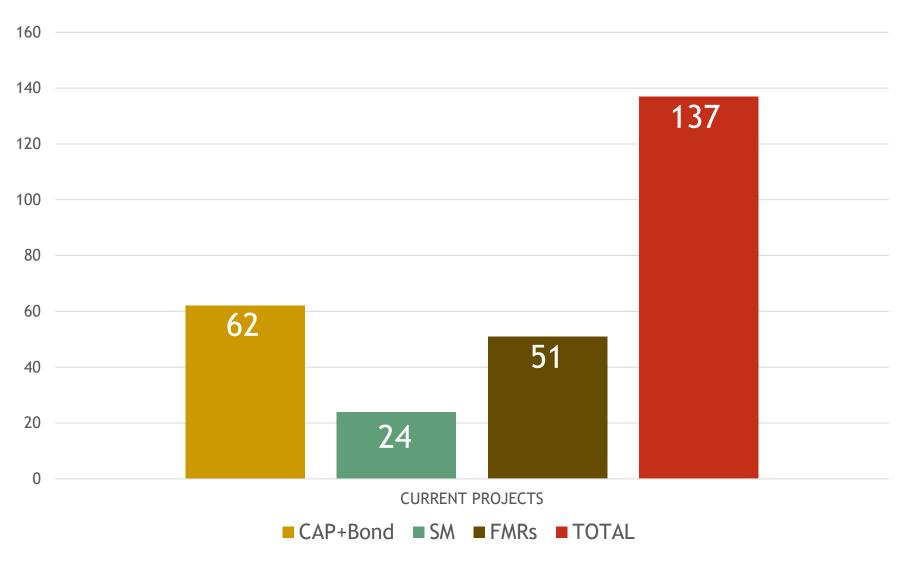
#### Needs: Unfunded Capital Projects

- Five-Year Capital Construction Plan (Facility Master Plan 2026-2030): \$1.2 billion
- ► Five-Year Scheduled Maintenance Plan & Repair Work (w/ADA): \$231 million
- Fire Life Safety Repair Work: \$14 million
- Stormwater & Sustainability Projects: \$69.6 million
- Safety/Security Projects (e.g. Key and Access Control Infrastructure) \$104 million
- ▶ Districtwide Technology Infrastructure (e.g. ITS): \$20.6 million

Note: Projects may be listed on multiple categories due to the nature of the scope of work (e.g. infrastructure and technology)

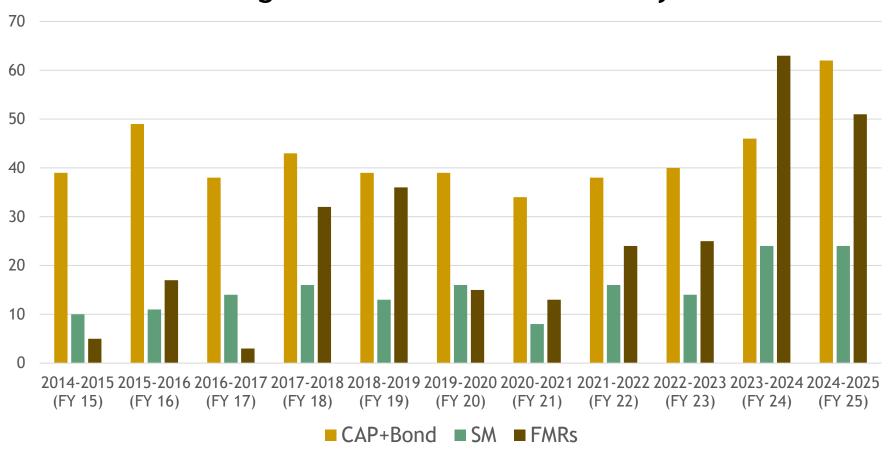
