Spring Event Summary

- 2. Student Success Summit: Part 1 May 8th
 - Webinar Link: May 8 success team panel
 - The Pilot Success Team for Future Educators paneled a webinar in which team members presented their work, successes and plans as a success team.
 - 47 attendees out of 57 registrants.
 - Received very positive feedback on this event, the panelists highlighted the excitement and the work required to accomplish several goals as a team.
 - The meaningfulness of the team seemed to spark interest in participating rather than reservations.
- 3. Student Success Summer: Part 2: May 22nd A follow-up event
 - This was the first meeting of our CAP Success Teams.
 - Was able to find two faculty members from STEM to participate, Mary Romero and Andy Gonis.

- Learning & Engagement team
 - Continuing casual 'Coffee with Colleagues' next Fall to assist with connecting faculty and offering any support for equity-minded practices during TRI in a casual setting. Will continue to be offered on Fridays addressing equity themes for discussion.
 - Weekly PD planning continues.
 - Team now has Jose Mercedes Lopez of SCE as a member.
 - Career Ladders Project will assist with Convocation Tuesday. Stephanie Clark is the contact for the event planning details. Maria Aguilar Beltran is the contact for the event agenda development.
- Web Redesign Ongoing project. no changes
 - Will be designing standards and best practices recommendations.
 - 13 major areas: First priority is Guided Pathways.



- Other areas include: Content, Forms, automatic updates for curriculum/maps, messaging, UX, Taxonomy/Navigation, Website management recommendation, and goal-oriented features.
- Designs will be reviewed this week.
- Continuing Education is launching its new redesign now and some parts of their implementation can be used at SAC.

Mapping Team

- Maps will be addressed in Fall and a process will be developed for annual review and updates of maps.
- Goal of addressing all certificates first, and then alignment of these to related AAs.

• Starfish Implementation – Ongoing. – no changes

- Starfish will allow for tracking early alerts, kudos, interactions, etc.. a variety of roles.
- Opportunity to work on Student Success Plans. These plans will serve as 'reminders' or 'to-do' items to stay on track.
