In answer to your questions below:

- 1. We receive a quarterly statement of the RMDF from ASCIP.
- 2. The fund is not audited by the district. However, those funds are included in ASCIP's annual audit.

The ASCIP determines if, when, and how much they can return to members of the JPA depending on their year-end financial results. Therefore, "rebate" is the appropriate terminology. RSCCD does not control, nor can we predict the amount or even if we will receive it. The timing of the rebate is within control ASCIP. The rebate amounts are separated based upon the different coverages we carry; liability, medical/dental and workers comp. Because of the large AB218 settlements that impact our liability insurance premiums, we have been advised that there will be major increases of nearly 7-figures. The rebates would be used to pay those costs. I am not sure how that lacks transparency. We don't "tout" the rebates. Any reference to them has been in response to questions asked. We do not treat them as ordinary income because they are not. The rebates are simply one-time funds the district periodically receives and are treated as such. Our focus throughout this process has been on the relative benefits, attributes and attendant costs of the various health and dental plans being offered to RSCCD employees.

Unfortunately, I have more questions.

- 1. Does the District receive a periodic accounting of the RMDF?
- 2. Is that fund audited, and does RSCCD receive the results of the any such audit of the RMDF?

I have always found the ASCIP "rebate" problematic.

Perhaps it's good business practice for ASCIP to hold onto the "rebate" for financial stability or because of the AB218 settlements (what is AB218, how has that and/or how might that affect RSCCD).

However, references to a "rebate" makes faculty believe that this money is going into the general fund. Based on your response, that is not what's going on.

This is not what I would call "transparent".

I would feel much better if instead of touting the benefits of the rebate, the faculty of RSCCD were given a clear description of what this "rebate" is and what it is not.

I believe sunlight is a good thing (unless I'm trying to observe the night sky), and it would be best to be crystal clear in this. Let's avoid innuendos, assumptions, or any other potential misinformation regarding either ASCIP or Aetna.
