Representative Duties

Installs, secures, repairs, updates, and maintains computers, printers, and peripherals; configures and validates cloning systems (i.e. imaging); identifies and resolves hardware and software problems on network; performs administrative activities developing instructional systems to improve efficiency; identifies and escalates network issues, collaborates with infrastructure network specialist regarding updates or patches for standard district software; provides guidance to the users in the use of standard or specialized desktop applications; communicates with staff and faculty regarding software and hardware needs; sets up, configures, administers, monitors, maintains, tests, and troubleshoots servers; maintains liaison with vendors.

Desirable Qualifications

Training and Experience

Any combination of training and experience equivalent to a Bachelor's degree in a technology field and two years experience in a networking environment. Experience may be substituted for education.
