Summary

For the purposes of this report, “**non-traditional**” refers to students enrolled in classes that meet at sites other than the main college campuses. These programs include Apprenticeships, Fire Academy, Contract Management, Criminal Justice Academy, Quality Assurance, Business Seminars, and courses delivered exclusively online or via television (do not include hybrid courses). Conversely, students identified as “**traditional**” are students who attend at least one class during the semester on campus.

- For the first time in the semesters included in this study (back to Fall 2004), **less than half** of students enrolled in each of RSCCD’s colleges’ credit program (both traditional and non-traditional alike) report that they reside inside the district’s service area cities.
- **Most** off-campus/non-traditional students (85% at SAC and 90% at SCC) report that they reside outside RSCCD boundaries.
- Overall, the greatest numbers of students from outside RSCCD boundaries reside in the cities of **Anaheim, Corona, Tustin, and Yorba Linda**.
- CEC’s student population is comprised primarily of Santa Ana residents (74%), and a comparable proportion of OEC’s students reside in the cities of Orange, Anaheim, and Santa Ana.
