





Construction Phasing Plan - CPP#1








Temporary Partition Plan – TPP#1

Notes:

Full Height Temporary Partition

Provide full height temporary partitions enclosing the restroom entrances as indicated on temporary partition plan, prior to start of demolition and construction activities

- Temporary construction swing out door with lock. Coordinate and confirm exact location with District
- White painted plywood facing the hallway side
- Full height wall pinned to floor
- Bracing for support
- Repair existing walls, floor, and ceilings after removal
- Provide protective floor covering in hallway and sticky floor mats in front of all partition doors and all affected areas
- Keep existing hallway accessible at all times
- Post construction safety signs on partition wall, facing hallway
- Clean and patch damaged existing surfaces

Notes for Construction Staging Plan:

- 1. Provide portable, full height fencing with screens to enclose the entire staging area prior to start of demolition.

- 4. Protect existing pavement used as construction staging area.
