

**Santiago Canyon College**  
**Transfers to Four-Year Institutions by Associate Degree-Earners**  
**October 2017**

In 2016-17, Santiago Canyon College (SCC) awarded 1,606 Associate degrees to their students. An unduplicated count of those students (some were awarded multiple degrees during Summer 2016, Fall 2016, Intersession 2017 and Spring 2017 sessions) results in 977. Transfer files (Summer 2016 through Spring 2017) were located at four-year institutions for 77% (749 out of 977) of the students who were awarded degrees by SCC. For those graduates:

- Three-quarters (576 out of 749) of the transfers to four-year institutions by SCC graduates enroll in colleges in the California State University system.
  - Over half (422 out of 749) of the transfers to four-year institutions by SCC graduates can be attributed to California State University, Fullerton.
  - The next highest numbers of transfers from SCC are to CSU Long Beach (8%) and CS Polytechnic Pomona (5%).
- Another thirteen percent (98 out of 749) of the transfers to four-year institutions by SCC graduates enroll in colleges in the University of California (UC) system. The highest numbers of transfers from SCC to the UC system can be attributed to UC Irvine (5%) and UC Los Angeles (3%).
- About ten percent (75 out of 749) of the transfers to four-year institutions by SCC graduates enroll in private or out-of-state universities such as Chapman University and Arizona State University (1% each).
- Liberal arts graduates (55%, 409 of 749) accounted for the highest number of transfers followed by business administration (11%, n=84), psychology (5%, n=39), and communication studies degrees (4%, n=33).

The numbers presented in this report underestimate the true number of transfers due to limitations in tracking students once they leave Santiago Canyon College. Despite these limitations, the transfer activity captured in this report provides valuable insight on student transfer and college degree completion. Note that student course enrollment or performance at their new college destinations are unavailable.
