Student Satisfaction Survey Results, Spring 2014**

**June 2014**

As an educational institution, it is imperative that we regularly monitor student satisfaction to understand how particular issues, if any, impact their perception in program offerings, support services and resources available, learning environment, as well as facilities usage as it relates to the Santa Ana College School of Continuing Education (SAC-SCE). Findings will assist us to serve students appropriately.

At the end of Spring 2014, staff conducted an online student satisfaction survey of the students actively enrolled at the five main SAC-SCE sites (Santa Ana College campus, Centennial Education Center, El Sol Center, Godinez High School and Santa Ana High School). The survey provided an opportunity for students to report their levels of satisfaction with the programs, services and resources available to them as SAC-SCE students. In addition, the survey included questions regarding their educational background, as well as questions regarding their employment status, family income, etc.

Respondents come from diverse demographic and economic backgrounds. Thirty percent have had some college education and 43% have less than a high school diploma. The majority of respondents are 30 years of age or older (67%), female (60%) and Latino (79%). Though respondents identified numerous native languages, three-fourths of the respondents' primary language is Spanish. More than two-thirds (69%) of the respondents reside in households of three or more family members, with low annual household income (72% with less than \$40,000 per year), and 53% worked (full and/or part time). Seventy-seven percent of them have their own transportation to school, while others depend on public transportation (13%), getting dropped off (9%), carpooling (2%) or walk (10%).

Many of the respondents (88%) took classes at the Centennial Education Center, 13% at the SAC main campus, and the remaining 2% at the Godinez and Santa Ana high schools. Slightly more than half of the respondents (52%) have been enrolled at SAC-SCE for less than a year, 32% from one to two years and 15% for three or more years. Participants come to SAC-SCE for various reasons: to learn English (54%), to obtain a better job (43%), to obtain high school diploma (33%), to obtain a CTE/computer training certificate (29%), to prepare for college/university studies (25%), and to help their children with school work (15%).

This report summarizes the opinions and perceptions of the 949 students who completed the survey. Data from this year will be compared to the survey conducted in 2012 to assist staff in comparing current and past performance.

## **Summary of Results:**

- Respondents enrolled at the SAC-SCE in various programs (*and therefore, may have more than one reason selected*). However, the majority are enrolled in the English as a Second Language program (54%), the Career Technical Education (CTE)/computer training program (31%), the Adult High School Diploma (19%), Adult Basic Education (10%), and GED coursework (3%).
- Respondents gave SAC-SCE a rating of 90% in “excellent” or “good” for overall experience! They were generally satisfied with the facilities, the quality of education, and the services they received at the SAC-SCE. They expressed appreciation for the availability of quality programs offered at no cost to students. Ratings for each area in these categories received rating similar or higher than in 2012. “Quality of instruction” had the highest gains of six percentage points.
  - Respondents gave highest ratings to “classroom experience” (95% of “excellent” and “good”) and “quality of instruction” (94%) and lowest ratings to availability of parking (56%).
  - “Appearance and maintenance of grounds/facilities,” “campus safety/security” and “convenience of classroom/site location” received ratings of 85% to 92% satisfaction.
  - “Class size,” availability of classes, variety of classes offered, and “books and learning materials” received 90% to 92% of excellent” and “good” ratings.
- Respondents do not use many programs and services made available to support them as they pursue their college education. Satisfaction ratings for support services, in general, were slightly lower for each category (other than admissions and assessment) than in 2012.
  - The most often used services were “required” ones in which they need to select and enroll in classes, such as Admissions and Registration Office (96%) and the Assessment/Orientation Office (88%). Both programs also received highest ratings of satisfaction from those who used their services, 92% and 90% respectively and are higher ratings than in 2012.
  - Less than half of the respondents (39%) use counseling services. Of those who did use the services, they gave it a rating of 86% satisfaction. Fewer students used this service and received slightly lower satisfaction rating than 2012.
  - Though some services were not used (by more than half of the respondents), they received general satisfaction ratings of 80% (Child Care Center) to 89% (Student Government Development Program/Leadership) from those who did use them.
- Respondents need the following courses to reach their goals: CTE/computer training (45%), ESL (41%), Adult High School Diploma (35%), GED (16%), ABE (13%), and Citizenship (9%).
- Word-of-mouth is the best form of advertisement for the SAC-SCE program (60%).

Comments were transcribed verbatim and grouped when similar thoughts were expressed. Participants complimented the helpful staff and faculty, the quality of education, as well as the many resources available; however, they also did not hesitate in making many suggestions for improvements (such as the need for better parking, better classroom technology, better classroom configuration to cut down noise, additional lab hours to complete assignments, etc.). Staff are encouraged to read the comments as they are very revealing.

### Instruction/Instructors
