Santa Ana College Athletic Hall of Fame Seeks Nominations For Class of 2005

Nomination deadline is March 8

SANTA ANA, CA – The Santa Ana College Athletic Hall of Fame selection committee is currently seeking nominations for induction into its third class, the Class of 2005. Nominees must have competed more than five years ago, coached more than two years ago or rendered extraordinary service and/or leadership to the Santa Ana College athletic program. Nominations must be received by the Santa Ana College Foundation office no later than 5 p.m. on Tuesday, March 8, 2005. Names submitted after the deadline will be kept on file and will be considered for future inductions.

The names included in this year's Santa Ana College Athletic Hall of Fame induction class will be announced during the awards dinner at the Ed Arnold Golf Classic on Tuesday, May 24, 2005 at Mile Square Golf Course in Fountain Valley, CA.

For nearly 90 years, Santa Ana College has maintained one of the top community college athletic programs in California which has produced some of the most talented student-athletes and coaches. To celebrate, recognize and honor the accomplishments of individuals who have made significant contributions as student-athletes, coaches or friends of the Santa Ana College athletic program, the college established the Santa Ana College Athletic Hall of Fame in 2000. The inaugural induction ceremony was held in fall 2003.
