SIXTH ANNUAL HAWKS GOLF TOURNAMENT IN MEMORY OF FRAN CUMMINGS

The Santiago Canyon College (SCC) Foundation and Athletics Department will hold their Sixth Annual Hawks Golf Tournament on Friday, April 28 at the Tustin Ranch Golf Club. This year's tournament will be played in memory of former SCC athletic director Fran Cummings, who lost her battle with cancer on May 30, 2005.

Friends and supporters from throughout Orange County will come together for a day of golf that will honor Cummings by raising funds for the SCC Foundation, new athletic programs and scholarships. Last year's tournament raised a record \$22,000 for student-athlete scholarships and the SCC athletic programs.

"Fran was the heart and soul of the annual Hawks Golf Tournament," said Juan Vázquez, SCC president. "From the first annual tournament in 2001 to the fifth tournament in 2005, her energy and spirit were the driving force behind this event."

Cummings joined the SCC faculty in 1997 where she served until her death as professor of exercise science and athletic director. Prior to that, she was an exercise science faculty member at Santa Ana College from 1991 to 1997. She also served as the women's volleyball coach at Cal State Fullerton from 1980 to 1988. Previously, she had coached and taught at Saddleback College.

This year's tournament will feature various golfing contests and prizes, along with a gift bag, raffle, 50/50 drawing and silent auction. Dinner and awards presentation will begin at 6:30 p.m. The cost is \$210/player or \$840/foursome. Reservations are currently being accepted and sponsorship opportunities are available.
