A Quick Note Conjunctive Adverbs:

- The job of a conjunctive adverb is to combine two ideas or clauses.
- When using a conjunctive verb, you **MUST** use either a period or semi-colon before the conjunctive adverb when combining two independent clauses. For example:
 - Many fruits and vegetables are grown in **Orange County**; **however**, not everyone has access to them.
 - Many fruits and vegetables are grown in **Orange County**. **However**, not everyone has access to them.

Here is a list of some common conjunctive adverbs:

additionally	consequently	in comparison	Moreover
also	finally	in contrast	on the other hand
besides	furthermore	in fact	Rather
certainly	however	instead	Therefore
comparatively	in addition	meanwhile	Thus
