2019-20 Successes:

- plan was submitted before the deadline by Dr. Sotelo
- Plan submission is a snapshot in time; representative and demonstrating continuous program improvement
- COVID and our rapid transition to TRI did not stop IET collaborations; documented in Plan
- Orange Area contributed the first 243 qualified Health collaboration
- Two tiers of the Digital Literacy pilot are included
- Noncredit Online is encouraged
- Initial testing of the Light Board technology at SCC has been promising
- Most improved facet of IET: Single Set of Learning Objectives

The Plan was shorter, more flexible, and more user friendly this year. It also attaches the EL Civics info directly with each individual collaboration, thereby making it career specific and tailored. Here is what the plan looked like this year:

Challenges/Lessons Learned:

- approval and funding were not given for an IET office in 2019-20; this has been requested since 2018
- Progress was made on including IET checkboxes, fields, etc in ed plans and registration but the work is slow
- The June-July sessions won't work with ELC, but an alternative WP component such as English For Work 2 could be attached instead during summers
- Late starts and early closures will make IET collaborations ineligible for 243
- Advance needs assessment, interdepartmental scheduling by deans, planning, and recruitment enable better success
- Hospitality/Restaurant workers typically work a 6 or 7 day per week schedule, so co-teaching model with single day of scheduled overlap and/or asynchronous DE will work best for these students

Looking Forward:

- Health/Medical Occupations will be expanding significantly in 2020-21
- This is part of the Consortium Three-Year Plan
- Matches our revised reality
- Tiers 3&4 Digi Lit have been approved and the Certificate is pending
