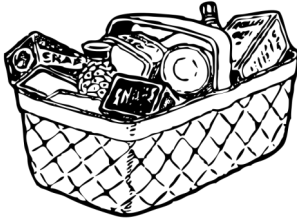

Stamp Out Hunger On May 10th Was a very successful Event!

In summer, holiday donations run out, food pantries run dry and demand for aid jumps. That's where a one-day food drive called [Stamp Out Hunger](#) comes in.

Organized by the National Letter Carriers Association and other agencies nationwide, Saturday's drive helped local food banks re-stock their pantries for the summer when the demand for food skyrockets.

Stamp Out Hunger is the only one-day food drive held simultaneously in almost every city in the country because the food drive itself is tied to mail delivery and pickup, said Paula Miller, Region 1 Food Drive Coordinator for the National Letter Carriers Association. What has made this food drive successful is its simplicity.

Last year 276,000 pounds of food, distributed to 470 OC Charities and providing 213,000 meals.
